Spark works with healthcare providers (HCPs) and healthcare organizations (HCOs) as part of our efforts to advance medical and scientific knowledge about the company's therapies and disease areas of interest. In maintaining an active dialogue with the scientific and medical community, there are instances when payments or other transfers of value are appropriately provided to these parties for legitimate business purposes. Through our transparency reporting, Spark tracks and reports these payments or other transfers of value pursuant to federal U.S. Sunshine Law and state and local transparency laws. Spark also reports payments and transfers of value if required by other countries' laws. These expenses may be for research or management of clinical trials; feefor-service payments for consulting, advisory board participation, or speaking engagements, including associated travel-related expenses; occasional meals associated with Spark-sponsored initiatives; grants and donations; costs of medical journal reprints; and the provision of select educational items.
